YCCC Membership Meeting December 13, 2023 (Page 1 of 2)

<u>Call To Order</u> – President Luke Simpson called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance

<u>President's Report</u> – President Simpson started off noting dates for the upcoming banquet and 2024 shows. The awards banquet will be April 13, 2024, the Thornton Car Show will be April 27, 2024, Markets at Shrewsbury July 13, 2024, and Corvettes at Carlisle August 24, 2024.

Luke thanked Faye Quigley for contacting Thornton Chevrolet, and Thornton agreeing to pay for YCCC's new parade banner. The banner acknowledgers Thronton as the club sponsor.

Luke noted that YCCC provided 17 cars for Northeastern High School's homecoming. Normally the club requests a \$10 donation to the charity per car provided. With the number of cars involved Barb Boyer just asked for whatever donation the school would like to provide. Surprisingly, the high school sent a \$500 donation to YCCC's charity fund. Thank you, Northeastern High School.

Luke asked Steve Vrabel to discuss the YCCC Toys for Tots campaign. The toys were on display at the meeting and Steve thanked all members who donated to the drive. Steve thought this year's collection may be the biggest the club has ever collected, noting that the Club has been participating in Toys for Tots for nine years. Steve also thanked Toys for Tots for all they do for York County children and thanked the Quigley's for providing the trucks to carry the toys. Steve also noted that \$158 was left unspent from this year and will be used as seed money for next year's campaign. He requested that members stay after the meeting to help load the toys in to the vans.

Chick Renn also noted that Toys for Tots may be losing the warehouse used to store toys and that they are looking for volunteers to help at the warehouse to prepare the toys for distribution.

<u>Membership Report</u> – Val Kosko noted that 78 members attended tonight's meeting and 67 meals were served.

Val asked membership if there were any new vehicles acquired or on order. Member Brian Franz noted that he has a 2024 Rapid Blue ZO6 on order

<u>Program Chairman's Report</u> – Mike Boyer noted that on December 16, 2023 the club will do a Christmas light drive through at Stone Gable Estate. Plan to depart the Wrightsville Rutter's at 6:00 PM. Instead of the normal \$30 per car Stone Gable will charge YCCC a flat \$150 for all the Corvettes that want to attend.

Mike stated that including Toys for Tots YCCC has raised over \$20,000 for our charities in 2023.

Alan Brandhofer stated that as of this meeting 89 spots are open for the Ocean City, NJ Boardwalk show. Those interested in attending need to register soon.

Kathy Gable stated that the Thornton Car Show will include a basket silent auction again in 2024 and asked for anyone interested in donating a basket to please let her know.


